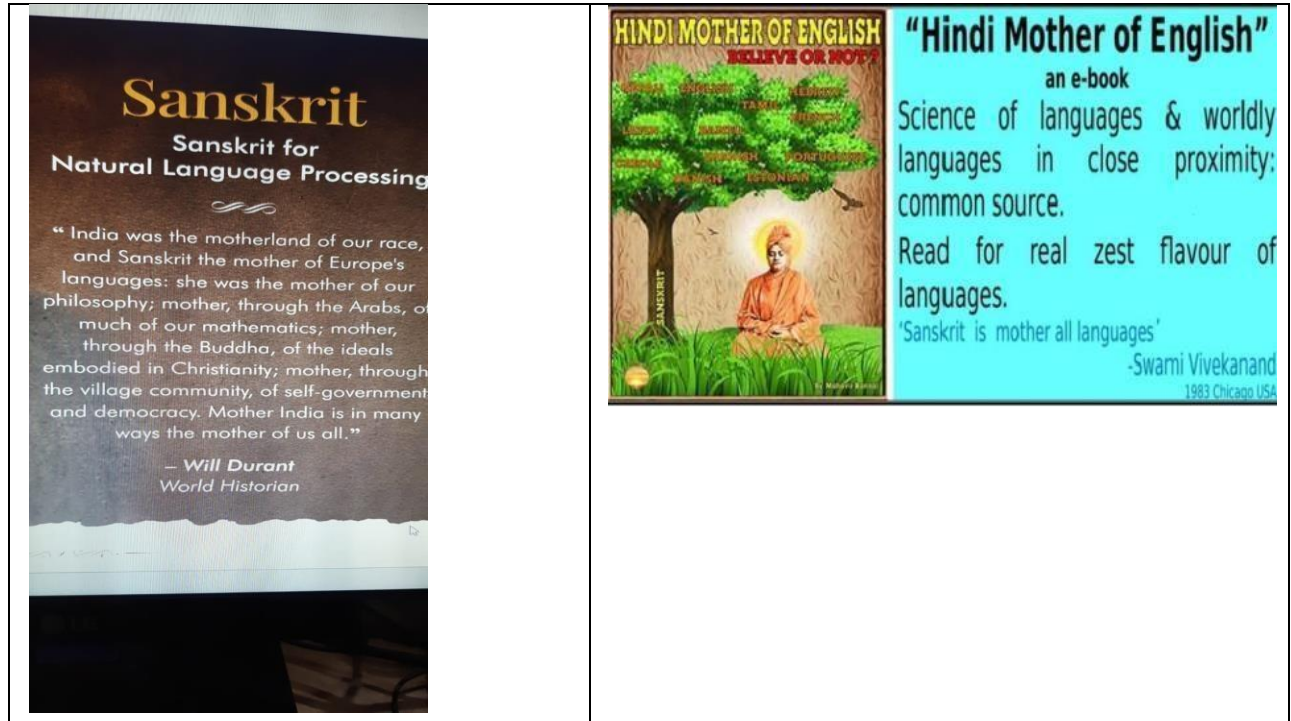

Mind: m + Ind (as Indian used to have):

Palindrome: pal/friend + Ind + Rome: universal (India and Rome=universe) and

Wind: powerful air : w+Ind=we India so powerful .

Index /Indicator as India was. **Industry/Industrious** : India used to be. **Individual** : single identification as India had .

Negative words:

Behind: be+hind: as India in backward gear. Likewise **hindrance** : obstacle as before India.

Rigid: Rig(Ved: holy Hindu text: tells worshiping methodology)+Id(Islamic fest): to be done without change: **inflexibility**.

Code: seeming small like *code*/leprosy but large effect.

Alien: a lion effect no one can touch like *share*=lion's share on one can touch.

Res-**Judi cata:** *ras*/rope which was connected now *cata*/disconnected(judge is also *juda*/connected with complete case/facts) Juda is called to a Jew (Jews are the best judges) .

Bar: wine shop, advocate council, a rod: from *bar*=outside: all these keep *bar*/outside who are not qualified and a barber's action is *bar ber*= repeat and outside area trimming only

Tort: ac act which *tor*/ break(trouble or torture). Actually word is .

Sui Cide : self making cide/side from life.

De+pose : to make nude(nothing hidden)

Warrant : war+nt/not ('rr' for vowel between two-consonant-rule) : a document to avoid conflict/war.

Order: *or*(=and)+ *der*(=fear): obey as well as feel fear.

Heinous crime : super wicked crime : (*hein*=week) henna because its effect diminishes.

Evidence: any *dent*/strong material which takes to **eve**/conclusion(: is strong and can **dent**).

Mitigate : *miti*+*gate* : to show gate of *meety*/clay: to make less severe (we *meet*/ eliminate in *meety*/ soil).

Regina : in English Regina is used in criminal cases for state i.e. queen powerful like a *gin*/ghost.

Hostile: *host*+*ill*(so backed out): who shall attend the guests(on one).

Prejudice: already connected(**judge**=connected with whole case)

Fraud=land revenue record where **fraud** was/is but obvious .

Forensic: *foren*/immediate: *sic*=learn else assessment/credibility may differ(for reaching **foreign** move *foreign*/immediate being distant: otherwise will get delayed like if one *late*= lays down one gets **late** or **late** forever).

We **pee** after *pee*=drink.

Out : o u tea : we throw tea leaves after boiling:

Town: t + own(unlike cities :unfriendly, village poor).

Tout : t + out : illegal middleman : needs to be out (*Tea* in Sanskrit means warm)

Scandinavian : etymology also its class words, **can**, **cannabis**, **Scan** etc

Holy/holi (in Hindi) a festival in Feb -March month(just a day before *fag*) while in (English) is pious and a no working day .

Workaholic: who works more than duef": As if were works even on *holi*(a day of complete holiday):

Choline : vitamin B : holy and essential for body which gives energy to body(it converts glucose into energy otherwise glucose alone can't).

Melancholy: long sadness as melan=meeting comes on Holy(last day of the Hindu calendar).

Hologram: a holy weighty logo remains hidden(so gram) and reflect on seeing carefully or in light (holo also from hollo/empty/hidden seems empty as if nothing were there).

Catholic(Roman Catholic): a universal race of Christianity: cat+Holic(holi+i+c/ exclamatory) : cat

either different group formed from existing-group(quit like cat i.e. cut)/ **holy**/religious group or fast moving like a cat(not orthodox like Baptist).Roman from Rome/ religion developed under Roman empire.

Holistic: an interconnected approach expressing **whole** thing *Holi* festival is the end of **whole** year (last day: till here whole/complete year passes) and *holi* is the **hole** between two years (from a **hole whole** canpass) and is **holy** and has a complete holiday. *Hole*(in Hindi) is called to roast pod of gram/ grain because it is roasted whole(with pod and plant) in burning fire as is burnt on *Holi*/festival and also during *holi* festival days(on plant gram fruit grows in the month of March). All above words contain *holi* or *hole* so not an iota doubt that these take meaning from *holi* festival.

Holi (in Punjabi /Hindi) is also used for slow and if we slow, reach late and *Holi* comes on the last day of Hindu calendar reaches to us *holi*/slowly(it seems i.e. at the end day of year).

Hollywood: name of central area in Los Angeles (CA: the USA) where film industry is set up. Either personification(but not appealing because no one directly connected and no direct name) or an holy/pious start in wood/forest area or *Holi* is the last day of the Hindu calendar and California is the last state and Los Angeles is the last city in west/ ahead is sea: also Hollywood Lake is there in Hollywood Hills(so all names not changed to Hollywood but pre-existing). Area has Sanskrit names

e.g. *zanja madre*(water source a century back in the area): *zanja* (in Sanskrit) is chain/streak-stream /channel and *madre*=mother(as if water sent by mother).

Cow elephant(feminine of elephant) milk has natural alcohol.

Hold: clench/ halt in hand as *Holi*/fest holds whole year.

Hollow= empty because *Holi* being the last day of the Hindu calendar nothing is left so as Police(like pole/bamboo=tall and empty : no powers) so as Hologram=hollow/empty but gram/weighty(combination of both). *Holly*: Holy as *Holi*(fest) so as Christmas tree (*Holly* shines like bright colours of *Holi* and both are pious, burning/lighting) and *Hollywood* its class word.

Holler : loud cry/shout as great ballyhoo on *Holi*.
